Stony Brook Museum Saturday, May, 13th @11:45a.m., (see below map and directions), This is a "completed all in one day" Merit Badge (if we don't have wet weather) which will be both fun to participate in as well as an educational opportunity. We will commence with a walking tour of the Sculpture instalments there at –LI Stony Brook Museum, followed by an outdoor clay creations session to complete the Merit Badge requirements and wrapping it up with a pizza Party!

I will be leading the Tour at the Museum set for 11:45 am Saturday, May 13, 2023. We will meet at the Eastern parking lot closest to the Carriage Museum and Picnic table area. It is across the street from the Museum's Visitor Center @11:45 am, located on the West side of 25a, (***see Parking lot nearest Bldgs.#9 & #10 in below map***), where we will be able to commence the tour. There will be an outdoor sculpture tour which should run approximately 30 minutes. Thereafter, we will meet in the Museum Picnic area, creating some clay sculptures of our own to complete the Merit badge requirements that same day.

Please bring a smock or an old t-shirt with you to the Museum, as we will be performing some sculpture work using clay.

Finally, there will be a pizza lunch that will follow the clay work on the Museum Picnic area.

Thereafter, all are welcome to view the rest of the Museum, and their crown jewel the "Carriage House Display," which is the "Largest Carriage collection in the World!"

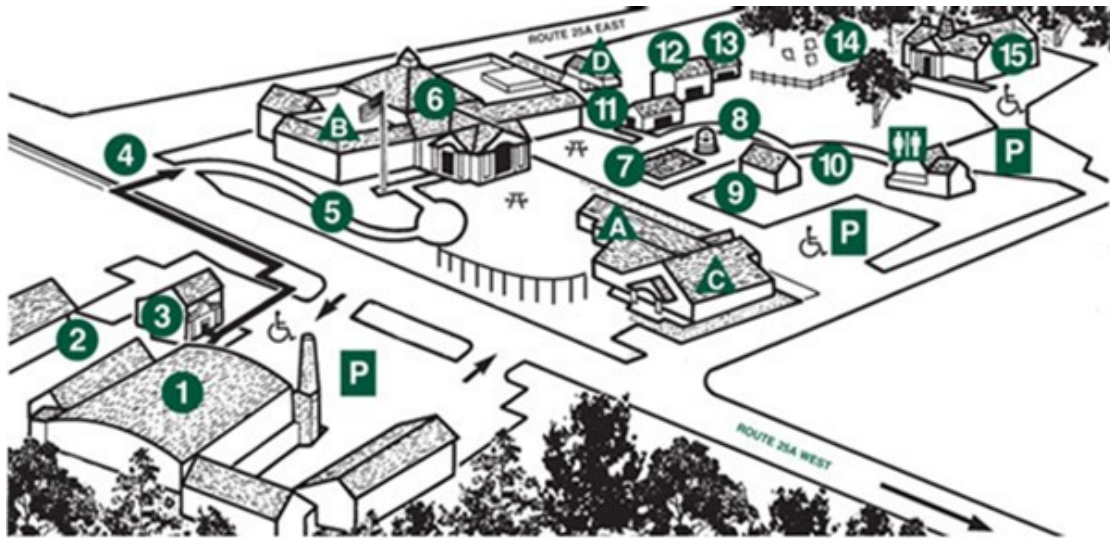
